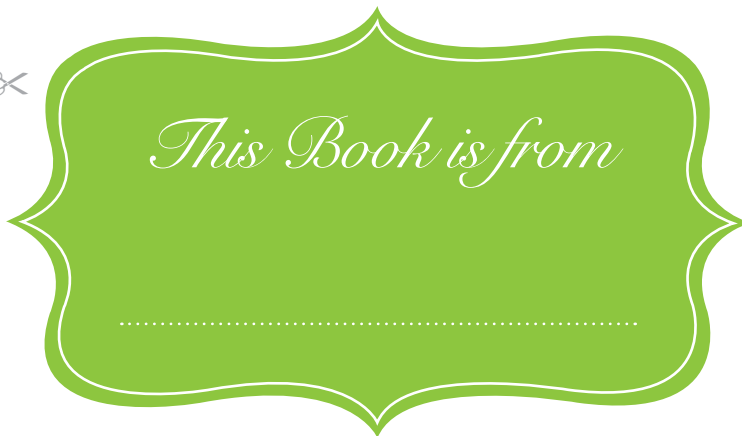
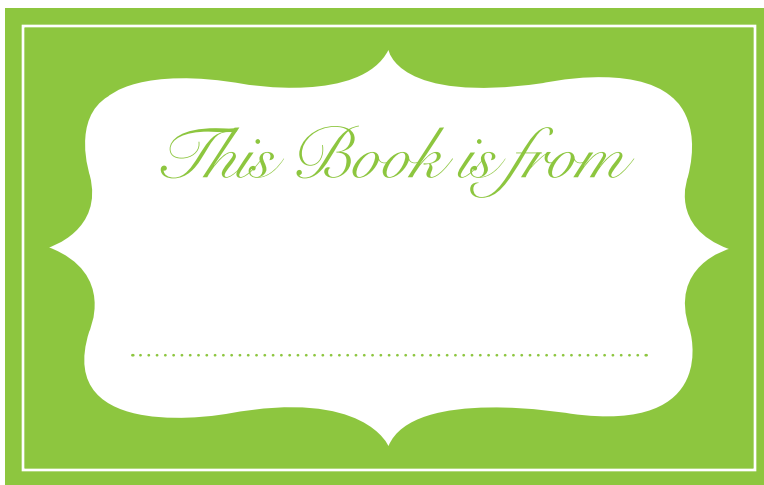


## Storybook Baby Shower Personalized Book Plate
