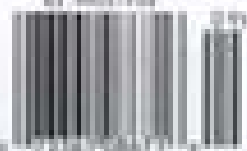

THE ARTIST

An aspiring painter or architect can go pro with a drafting table and a stool; those shown here have adjustable heights. Add a storage cabinet with shallow drawers for finished works, and paint a graphic wall display for hanging tools of the trade.

THE SPRAWLER

If you have a little ramblin' man—that is, a child who likes to spread out while he works or plays—don't fence him in. Pair a large, round table, which provides plenty of surface space, with a big, cushy rug for when the action moves to the floor. Nesting cubes can be reconfigured to keep up with his shifting mountains of stuff, and a color-coded accordion file will keep paper piles at bay.
